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Thank you for your interest in St. Patrick Regional Secondary School's International Student Program. Please carefully read the following instructions and program information.

Submitting an Application

To apply to St. Patrick's International Student Program, please complete the following steps:

- 1. Complete the application form and have it signed by parent and student, **not** the guardian or agent.
- 2. Attach original transcripts or school records from both the current and the previous school year in English. Photocopies of transcripts/certificates must be certified with the school's official stamp.

Application Process

After receiving a **completed** application package and application fee, the school will notify applicants as to their acceptance status. A pre-acceptance letter will be mailed to the applicant. The applicant will have 14 days to accept the seat at St. Patrick and pay the \$5000.00 non-refundable deposit.

An official Letter of Acceptance will be issued to successful applicants once the deposit is received by the school. With this official Letter of Acceptance, applicants can apply for their Study Permit at the nearest Canadian Embassy.

Once the applicant has been notified of his/her acceptance, the tuition must be paid in full by August 30th by a certified cheque or money order payable to St. Patrick Regional Secondary School.

Upon acceptance, the following documents must be provided to the school:

- Notarized letter from parents appointing guardian for student (if required)
- Notarized letter from guardian accepting responsibility for the student (if required)
- Guardian's proof of Canadian citizenship or Permanent Resident/Landed Immigrant Status
- Copy of student's passport (and study permit if student is already studying in Canada)
- Copy of student's Care Card or proof of medical coverage (if student is already studying in Canada)

Refund Policy

In the event that an applicant does not come to Canada or decides to leave St. Patrick Regional Secondary for personal reasons, a refund request must be made in writing. The following refund policy will apply to all international students:

- Full refund, less Application Fee, if the Study Permit is not approved by Citizenship and
 Immigration Canada. Students must include the letter of rejection from the Canadian Embassy. The
 student must also provide the Cancellation of Custodianship Declaration-Custodian for Minor
 Studying in Canada, and the original copy of notarized Custodianship Declaration-Custodian for
 Minor Studying in Canada. The school will not process the refund before the student provides the
 above documents.
- The student shall pay the balance of tuition fees and register as soon as possible after he/she obtains a student visa. If the student has not paid the balance of tuition fees, or registered, or provided the school with reasonable explanation before the school start date, the school will not refund any of the

\$5,000.00 deposit. The school will notify the Canadian Immigration Office to cancel this student's visa.

- No refund of the tuition fee if the student withdraws after the first calendar month of the program.
- No refund of the tuition fee if the student is found to be in violation of school rules as per school policy, i.e., chronic absenteeism, drinking alcohol, taking drugs, etc.

Tuition Fee: \$17,000.00

Additional costs include, but are not limited to, school uniform (regular and summer), physical education uniform, school supplies, special subject and extra-curricular fees, field trips and special school functions.

Homestay

St. Patrick Regional Secondary does not organize homestay programs. You are encouraged to contact outside homestay agencies. These programs offer International students an opportunity to practice speaking English and to learn about Canadian culture while living with a local family. Families are chosen because of their commitment to involving students in family life and their interest in learning about other cultures.

The student must agree to be culturally sensitive and respectful to students from other countries and students from their own country. There will be other speakers of your native language; however, you must agree to use English while in the classroom.

If a student participates in any of the extra-curricular athletic programs, they must have a physical examination annually.

No new international students are permitted to obtain a driver1s license while attending the school.

Overview of the International Student Program and EAL/ESL



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St. Patrick Regional Secondary is a Roman Catholic Secondary School in Vancouver teaching grades 8-12 university preparation curricula.

It is the intent of this program to offer international students the opportunity to experience Vancouver while continuing their secondary school education. Accordingly, the program involves ESL courses and components in order to integrate students into the mainstream program. Each student's language abilities are determined by an analysis of test results and grades in regular courses. The goal of all ESL courses is to maximize student exposure to academic English. Students will be directed to reach a high level of proficiency in the English language with the intention of future admission into a future Post-Secondary Institution. Therefore, students will receive an individual schedule developed around the student's goals and needs to lead them to success.

The ESL program will offer an eclectic combination of speaking, reading, writing, listening grammar and vocabulary as well as structured TOFEL preparation. Not all students will require or want all sections—consequently may not participate in all the ESL courses offered.

The integration of students into mainstream courses will ensure that students continue to improve their language skills and additionally develop their skills in other subjects. Throughout this memorable experience, students will not only improve their English language but will also become a part of the St. Patrick student community as a whole.
